- 3. ensuring that teachers, principals, other school leaders, and other staff who serve Indian students have the ability to provide culturally appropriate and effective instruction and supports to such students.

To qualify for services, the child, or parent of the child, or grandparent of the child must be

enrolled in a recognized tribe.
