For Grades K-2: River Academy will utilize district curriculum and assessment materials including ELA (Benchmark Advance, Michael Heggerty, NEWSELA, and TWR), Math (Bridges and Dreambox), Science (Mystery Science), SEL Health, and SPARK.

For Grades 3-12: River Academy is partnering with Odysseyware to offer state approved and grade level appropriate online curriculum.

The core of the Odysseyware online learning program is a robust course library of standards-aligned, dynamic and pedagogically sound curriculum. The curriculum is designed to empower students to build proficiency, achieve content mastery, and engage in rich and challenging real world applications.

There are many reasons to remain enrolled with your local school district...

- K-12 students are connected with highly qualified Klamath Falls City School teachers.
- K-12 students have access to face-to-face support as needed, along with several methods of contacting their local teacher.
- 9-12 students can participate in dual credit options in the Klamath Falls City Schools.

- 9-12 students may have access to academic and elective programs such as theater, band, choir, art, and media design offered in the Klamath Falls City Schools.
- K-12 students enrolled in the district receive free meals through the Klamath Falls City School's Food Service Program.
- 6-12 students may be able to participate in sports, after school tutoring, and extracurricular activities at their neighborhood school.
- K-12 students have access the school-based counseling services and therapeutic counseling offered via a partnership with Klamath Basin Behavioral Health.
- K-12 students with IEP's and 504's have the support of the Klamath Falls City School Special Services Department to accommodate the individual needs of each student.
- K-12 students are each provided a Chromebook, internet access if needed, and local technology support.
- K-12 students can more easily transition in and out of the traditional Klamath Falls City Schools in 6-week sessions.
- K-12 students have more flexibility to complete school work around their individual needs and schedules.
- 3-12 parents have access to a portal so they can track academic progress at any time.
- Educational state funding stays with the Klamath Falls City Schools, enhancing and supporting the local community.
