Safety Upgrades Coming To Roosevelt

There has been a lot of discussion about the easy access to the inside of our school and what can we do to limit that access and make our students and staff safer.

Dr. Hillyer, along with a team from the district office, have gone out to all buildings to see what can be done and start developing plans for improvements. I'm happy to report that Roosevelt will be one of the first schools to receive these improvements.

The plan is put doors at the bottom of the main stairs to limit access to the main floor. These doors and the doors at the top of the stairs will

then be locked at a predetermined time every morning with access out the doors from the hallway side available at all times. A door to the office will be added at the top of the landing which will then require all visitors to check in with office staff before entering the school.

The doors have been ordered and a contractor hired. We are hoping that construction will start in the next month or two.
