Registration Fees and Policies

- Individual student rate \$30.00 per year. You can make a one-time payment or pay three payments of \$10.00. Payments are due: October 14, 2016, January 20, 2017, and April 22, 2017.
- Family rate \$50.00 per year. You can make a onetime payment or pay three payments of \$17.00, \$17.00, and \$16.00. Payments are due: October 14, 2016, January 20, 2017, and April 22, 2017.
- Financial Assistance options are available if you are unable to pay the registration fee. The program director and appropriate site coordinators will work with you on our registration fee with the following options:
 1. Volunteering- each hour of volunteer time is equal to \$10 towards your balance. You must fill out a form and be approved through the district office for this volunteer option)
 2. Scholarship assistance- A fee waiver is available and must be approved by Gayle Yamsaski.
- An applicant's fee approval will be valid for the entire 2016-2017 school year.
- Applicants must complete the form in full and return it to the school secretary's office or schools' site coordinator for processing. *Processing can take up to one week.
