RESOLUTION FOR OPEN ENROLLMENT LAW


WHEREAS, the effective date for House Bill 3681 (HB 3681) was January 1, 2012, and,

WHEREAS, the Klamath Falls City Schools has reviewed board policy JECB – Admission of Nonresident Students to ensure compliance with this law,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Klamath Falls City Schools that based on enrollment projections, staffing and/or available resources limited numbers of nonresident grades K-5 students shall receive written consent for admission under ORS 339.133(5)(b) for the 2017-2018 school year. All requesting nonresident 6-12 students will receive written consent for admission under ORS 339.133(5)(b) for the 2017-2018 school year. Open enrollment preference will be given to nonresident students and their siblings who are already enrolled. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until allotments are filled. These numbers are as follows:
