The total number of incidents of physical restraint; **Three**

The total number of incidents of seclusion; **One**

The total number of seclusions in a locked room; **Zero**

The total number of students placed in physical restraint; **Three**

The total number of students placed in seclusion; **One**

The total number of incidents that resulted in injuries or death to students or personnel as a result of the use of physical restraint or seclusion; **Zero**

The total number of students placed in physical restraint and/or seclusion more than 10 times in a school year; **Zero**

8. The total number of physical restraint and seclusion incidents carried out by untrained individuals; **Zero**

The demographic characteristics of all students upon whom physical restraint and/or seclusion was imposed; **Two males, one female. Two students with IDEA eligibility, one student with ADA eligibility. Two of three students have placement in self-contained classrooms specifically designed to meet the needs of students with behavior challenges. All staff that were involved with the restraint have current CPI training and all staff and parents participated in debriefing session that included revision to behavior support plans.**

10. The total number of rooms available-for use by the district for seclusion of a student and a description of the dimensions and design of the rooms. **Two rooms identified in the district for seclusion locations, both sites meet the legal requirements of size and logistics.**

This report shall be made available to the Board and to the public at the special education office and on the district's website.

At least once each school year the public shall be notified as to how to access the report.

The district shall investigate all complaints regarding the use of restraint and/or seclusion practices according to the procedures outlined in Board policy KL and KL-AR - Public Complaints.

The superintendent shall develop administrative regulations to carry out the requirements set forth in this policy and to meet any additional requirements established by law related to the use, reporting and written documentation of the use of physical restraint or seclusion by district personnel.
